2023 Cover Artist

Anne Hempel creates all her work on hand-crafted wood panels that her husband, a biologist, builds for her. Most people describe her work as making them feel happy and light, more connected to nature. Anne paints what catches her eye and heart in nature, focusing on flowers, birds, trees, fields, and water. Every painting has a story.

She applies multiple layers of thickened acrylic paint creating an impasto style that reflects light and adds expressiveness to the painting. She uses glazes and washes in between layers to build rich color and highlight the texture. Her process evokes a time-weathered patina. The canvas being wood makes the perfect surface for using a palette knife and various tools to carve into the wet paint creating a kind of three-dimensional sculptural rendering.

Anne graduated from Florida State University. She taught elementary school as well as English in Japan. She has been a full-time artist for over 15 years and participated in the Chain of Parks Art Festival for 11 years. As an accomplished artist, Anne participates in many juried competitions and shows featuring her distinguished work. She conducts painting workshops for adults, private painting lessons, and summer art camps for children. She is represented at Signature Art Gallery in Tallahassee and has had a long-term relationship with LeMoyne Arts. Anne is married and has a young daughter; she loves being outdoors and volunteering in her community.

2023 Festival Judges

This year we have three out of town judges, each paired with a local art patron judge to assist in the judging process, awarding cash prizes totaling over \$10,000. Each team will focus on a set of mediums to award prizes. To support our Green the Festival initiative, the Recycled Content Art Award will be presented for a singular piece of work. We want to thank our judges for taking the time to judge the 150 outstanding artists at this year's show.



David Begley is an Associate Professor at University of North Florida, and teaches Graphic Design + Digital Media courses with a focus on Typography, Visual Identity and a variety of upper-level electives. Begley received his Masters of Fine Art from the Savannah College of Art and Design, with a focus on Social Design and Advertising Design. He has served as Education Co-Chair and is currently on the Advisory Board for AIGA Jacksonville, and remains close with industry contacts. Begley has worked as a designer in New York City, NY and Denver, CO, and continues working on projects with clients throughout the country. His work has been honored and reproduced in national awards publications, and at the international level, having designed the logo for the Sea Island Georgia G8 Summit. He continues to work with design students to promote diversity and inclusion in the design industry.



Cat Gambel Cat Gambel is a visual artist from New Orleans, Louisiana, her work explores material impermanence and small narrative continuities across generations and geographies. Cat received her M.A. in Art & Process from Crawford College of Art & Design in Cork, Ireland. Subsequently, she was awarded the CCAD Graduate Artist in Residency, during which she collaboratively worked with asylum-seeking women living in Irish Direct Provision.

Cat currently serves as the director of The Art Gallery (TAG) at the University of West Florida in Pensacola, where she also hosts community ceramic pit fires.



Kyoungim Park is an Associate Professor of Interior Design in the Department of Art & Design at Valdosta State University with a diverse background in fine arts and interior design. She is an interior design educator as well as an artist with an MFA degree in Painting. She has exhibited her works regionally and internationally, including in Florida, Georgia, Poland and South Korea. She is also a LEED accredited professional ID+C. Her research focuses on the design of environments for the elderly. She is also interested in biophilic design, sustainable design, and interior design that promotes human health and well-being within a built environment.

Carlos Alberto GH is a painter from Guadalajara focused on street art with a degree in art conservation. He has participated in festivals around Mexico, the United States and Canada, as well as several European and Asian countries, winning awards in international competitions. He has been recognized by the United Nations and his works have been included in various printed and virtual publications worldwide. Carlos was originally scheduled to participate in the 2020 Chain of Parks Festival which was canceled due to the Pandemic. We are delighted to have him back to create a masterpiece!

Naomi Haverland has been painting for as long as she can remember and has been “doing chalk” since 2011. She specializes in humorous and hyper-realistic portraits.
